Member Enrichment: Guided Hike

Miloli'i Ridge Road hike in Koke'e State Park

This 3 mile round-trip hike will show hikers great examples of Mesic Forest native species (no collections, please). The unpaved road is fairly level but may be slippery, so wear appropriate footwear. On a difficulty scale of 1-5 (with 5 being extreme), this hike rates about a 2. This is a hunting area, so please wear orange for safety! We encourage you to carpool to Koke'e due to limited parking.

We will meet up at 8:30 am and hike until about 2:00 pm.
